The Fine Print

As a reminder, here is our fundraising policy, as accepted at registration:

Each Ardrossan Strathcona Figure Skating Club family will be required to participate in fundraising for each session your skater is registered for. Details of fundraising activities will be provided at the start of each session. Fundraising requirements are split into the Fall Session (Sept-Dec) and Winter Session (Jan-Mar).

Should you choose to not participate in fundraising during the session you are registered in, you will be required to pay a \$100 fee in lieu of fundraising. This \$100 can be paid by e-transfer to info@asfscoline.com or can be charged to your credit card on file.

Fall 2024 Fundraising Requirement - participation in Sept-Dec 2024 fundraisers, or \$100

Winter 2025 Fundraising Requirement - participation in Jan-Mar 2025 fundraisers, or \$100

Note: By accepting this policy, you are approving that the \$100 charge per session will be added to your credit card on file, should you not participate in fundraising as noted above.

Fundraising Instructions

For both SoupTime and Bouma Quality Cuts:

- 1. Use the provided form to sell to your family, friends, etc.
 - a. Combine all your orders into one form. Or you can use more than one if you prefer.
- 2. Collect money from your sales and submit to ASFSC.
 - a. Have each customer pay you directly, then submit a single payment to us for all your orders combined. Tax is included.
 - b. E-transfer is the easiest option. Send payments to info@asfsconline.com.*Please note which fundraiser and your skater's name in the comments on your payment.
 - c. Cheque and cash can be accepted if an e-transfer is not feasible for you. Cheques payable to "Ardrossan Strathcona Figure Skating Club."
- 3. Bring your paper order forms back to the rink.
 - a. We will have an envelope in the office to collect forms.
 - b. <u>Do not</u> leave any money in the office or with coaches; make sure payments go to a member of the executive team.
 - c. You are welcome to email your form in as well.
- 4. Pick up your order from the rink when it is ready.
 - a. We will send out an email when orders are ready with more instructions. We will need to ensure everything stays cold and can adjust individual pickups as needed.
- 5. Distribute to everyone who ordered from you!

Please visit souptime.ca for a description of all soups (and desserts) available. Please note that the price on the website is not the fundraising price and the multi-packs are not available. Some options are limited time only and we will confirm availability when ordering.

Bottle Drive:
